VET in Slovakia: in a nutshel

MAIN FEATURES:

- Population of 5.5 mil.
- A strong VET tradition, about 70% of secondary education students participating in VET programmes
- 424 VET schools
- Since 2015 dual VET
- Strengthening ties between VET and employers

MAIN CHALLENGES:

- High risk of automation
- High employment in manufacturing cars and electronics
- Low participation in lifelong learning
- Increasing early-leaving from education and training
- Shortage of equipment and digital skills
- Lack of digital learning sources

- 2014 → 2017 / 2017 → 2020
 - introducing quality culture in VET / peer review methodology / understanding the quality cycle
 - → attracting VET providers to quality issues
 - → using available sources
 - Erasmus+ mobility project study visits for policy-makers, VET providers, other actors

EQAVET NRP: quality-assurance

ROLE OF EQAVET NRP: 2020 → 2023

- Supporting introduction of peer review in one region (43 VET schools) + more VET providers (recently 6 VET schools interested in peer review)
- Refining the peer review methodology www.okvalite.sk
- Introduction of Prize for Quality on VET
- Establishment of the national network for quality (Erasmus+ Strategic Partnership project QUANTUM + accredited mobility for quality assurance)
- Involvement in qualifications and validation systems QA
